Call for Abstracts

The e-Conference intends to unveil contemporary issues associated with the multifaceted areas of Japanese Studies with an emphasis on the changing dynamics of Japanese society, economy, politics and governance, science and technology, art & culture in the emerging global order. The theme of the e-conference is 'Japanology in New Era'. Interested scholars are requested to submit abstracts for this grand e-Conference. Authors of the selected abstracts will be invited to present their papers in the International e-Conference. There will be a plenary paper titled Japanology and Japanologist in New Era, among others.



ABSTRACTS can be submitted on the following themes, but need not to be limited to them:

1. Japan and Japanology, traits of new Japanologists, necessity of multidisciplinary Japan Study.
2. Japan in the post-COVID-19 era.
3. Japanese foreign policy, Japan in international affairs, Japan vis-a-vis South-East and South Asia, and Japan-Bangladesh relations in the emerging new world order.
4. Japanese history, society, culture, language, literature, and media. Comparative folk culture: Japan vis-a-vis South-East Asia, South Asia and Bangladesh.
5. Japanese economy, business, industry and investment.
6. Human resource development in Japan: education and training, health and demography.
7. Japanese political economy and political economists, Marxist tradition in social sciences in Japan and Japanese intellectual domains.
8. Japanese governance, government, politics and public policy.
9. Science and technology in Japan.
10. Japanese soft power policy and ODA.
11. Human rights in Japan.
12. Perspectives on future of Japanese economy, society, and governance.

2. Send the abstract in one single word file and write the paper title, your name and abstract. Please write a short bio underneath of the abstract (not exceeding hundred words).
3. The abstract shall not exceed 300 words.
4. Font: Times New Roman (size heading 14 and text 12)
5. Language: English
